Distance learning and Summer school

Students can obtain an MA in Peace and Reconciliation Studies by means of a combination of distance learning and a two week summer school over a one or a two year period. This involves the following:

Stage one. Completion of our *Postgraduate Certificate in Conflict Resolution Skills* - this is taught by means of distance learning and a two week Summer school usually held in July.

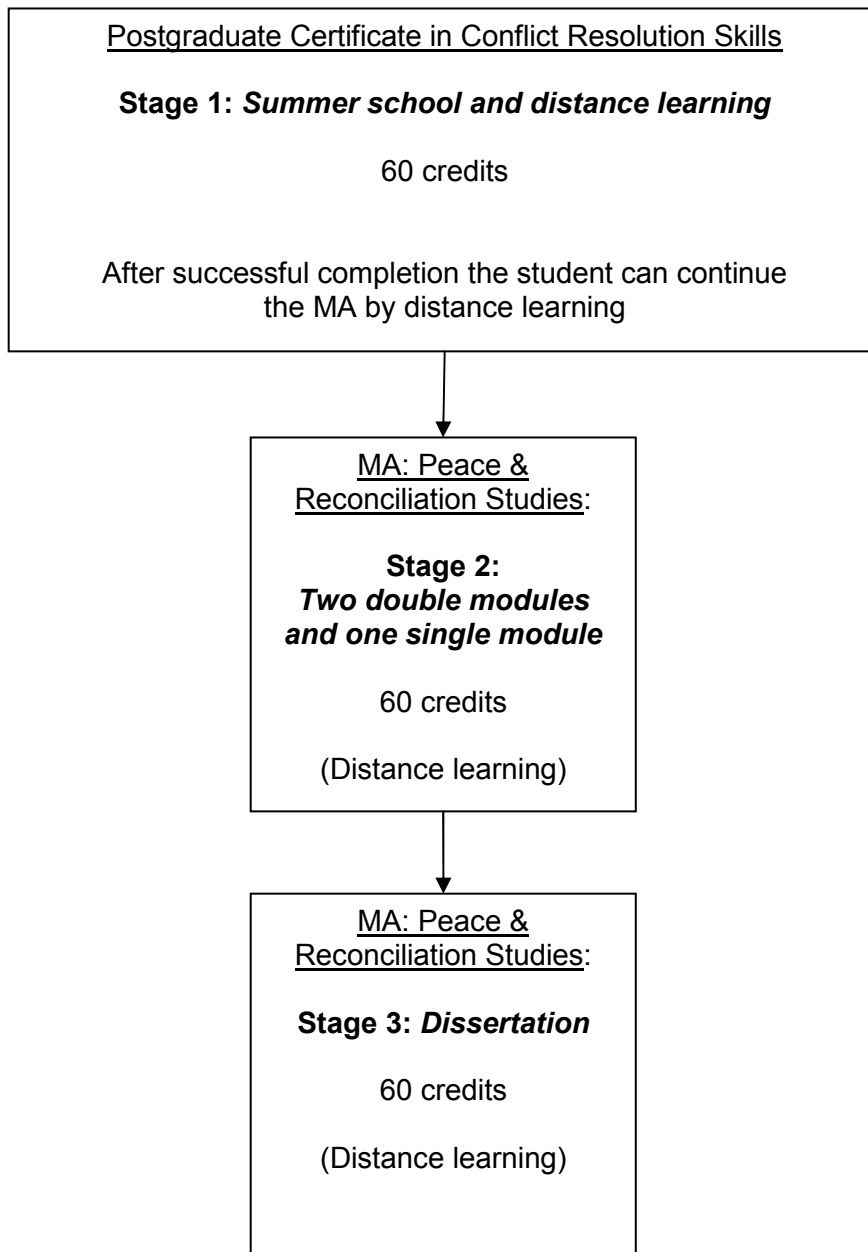
Successful students who satisfy the requirements for the *Postgraduate Certificate* award (which carries 60 postgraduate credits) can transfer the credits to our MA in Peace and Reconciliation Studies. They can join the MA programme at the second of its three stages, and complete stages two and three by distance learning without any requirement to be resident in Coventry.

Stage two consists of two double modules (*Comparative Peace Processes and Religion, Conflict and Peace* and a single module *Research Design*. (two double modules plus one single module - 60 credits). Successful students are eligible for the award of *Postgraduate Diploma in Peace and Reconciliation Studies* and can progress to stage three.

Stage three. To obtain the award of MA, students must submit a dissertation of 15,000 words.

Supervision and tutorial support throughout both these stages can be delivered by distance learning. (See diagram below). Students choosing to follow the distance learning route to our MA award can complete the programme over a one or a two year period.
